
ST. LUKE CATHOLIC CHURCH Hamilton, Ontario

Special features of the campaign will enable us to maximize the positive effects of our fundraising:

- First, we keep 75 percent of what we raise up to our minimum target, which is \$272,000.
- If we raise \$272,000, we will receive a \$54,400 matching amount from the campaign! That means we could receive from the campaign nearly as much as we raise.
- We will keep 85 percent of anything we raise beyond \$272,000.
- There are virtually no costs to the parish for the campaign. The diocese is picking up those costs. All the money raised will be used for campaign projects.



What an opportunity! We want to maximize this chance to undertake a vital renewal of our parish.
